RE: 6 January 2021 EPA Ban or Restriction of PBT Substances

Dear Chemtronics Customers,

On 6 January 2021 the US EPA issued final rules banning or restricting five persistent, bio-accumulative and toxic (PBT) substances, the CAS numbers associated with these materials are as follows:

| Substance | CAS # | Common Use |
|--|------------|---|
| Phenol, isopropylated, phosphate (3:1) (PIP 3:1) | 68937-41-7 | flexible plastics, polyurethane and polyethylene foam (EMI gaskets) |
| Decabromodiphenyl Ether (DecaBDE) | 1163-19-5 | flame retardants |
| Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd) | 87-68-3 | rubber compounds, as a solvent and hydraulic fluids |
| Pentachlorobenzenethiol (PCTP) | 133-49-5 | production of rubber materials |
| 2,4,6-Tri- <i>tert</i> -butylphenol (2,4,6-TTBP) | 732-26-3 | antioxidant. chemical manufacturing |

None of these substances are currently used nor ever included in any Chemtronics chemical product or article
